GENERAL SLC COMPETITIVE EVENT GUIDELINES

Students are not required to compete in all listed options for their division. These guidelines are the maximum number of events allowed.

Secondary Students (High School)

- ✦ Up to 2 Competitive Events selected from the 5 categories. Each event must be in a separate category
- ✦ HOSA Bowl (team of 4; this is counted as a separate event, although listed under Teamwork)
- ✦ Any ATC National Geographic Tests (*recommended* limit of 3)
- ✦ Anatomage Anatomy & Physiology Tournament
- ✦ Any Recognition Events (see guidelines above, no limit)
- ✦ HOSA History Exam
- ✦ HOSA History Exam

Middle School Students

- ✦ Up to 3 Competitive Events
- ✦ HOSA Bowl (team of 4)
- ✦ Any Recognition Events (see guidelines above, no limit)
- ✦ HOSA History Exam

Post-Secondary/Collegiate Students

- Up to 2 Competitive Events
- Any ATC National Geographic Tests (*recommended* limit of 3)
- Any Recognition Events (see guidelines above, no limit)
- HOSA History Exam
