Testing

- All testing will be on-site
- **Bring #2 pencils – no mechanical pencils.** Always bring more than one pencil
- Only National Geographic tests will be online. Deadline: February 15
 - For ATC (Nat. Geo.) tests: First one is free, then additional tests are \$10
- Testing times – Mon. March 2 Testing Center opens at 8:30
 - Students must be in Testing Center by 10:30
 - If taking more than one test, must be there by 9:15
 - **HOSA History Test** will be taken separately during conference. Time TBA
- **HOSA Bowl** will test on Tuesday immediately after dinner
- Students will be responsible to monitor time using wall clock in front on the stage
 - When students check in, entry time will be noted at top of Test page
 - There will be no Orientation; instructions will be on the top page of test.
 - All tests are 60 minutes; students will be responsible for watching the time – there will be no announcements of time remaining.
 - Students will have a total of 67 minutes to get to their seat, get organized, take test, and return test to table where they got the test
 - When finished, person at table will write time at top of page under start time
 - If student is to take another test, they may obtain that test after turning in the first one.
 - At check-out, they will be asked to sit at a table and take survey from a QR code.
