

HOSA APPENDIX G

ACCEPTABLE FORMS OF PHOTO IDENTIFICATION FOR COMPETITIVE EVENTS

1. The competitor must present a valid photo ID issued by a city, state, or federal government agency or by the competitor's school.
2. The first and last name must match the one on the event registration.
3. The photo must be current and recognizable.
4. A photograph (digital or print) of the valid photo ID is also acceptable.
5. Examples:
 - a. Government-issued driver's license or non-driver ID card
 - b. Official school-produced student ID card from the competitor's school (per #1).
 - c. Government-issued passport or U.S. Global Entry identification card
 - d. Government-issued military or national identification card

If the competitor does not have an acceptable form of ID as listed above, the HOSA Competitor Identification Form, found in this Appendix, may be completed and used as a substitute.

6. [Per the GRRs](#), at ILC, all competitors must have photo identification for each round of competition. If a competitor comes to the competition and does not have the proper photo ID, then the competitor will be allowed to compete but will receive 35 penalty points. Points will be deducted in Tabulations. For round 2 Biomedical Debate, HOSA Bowl, Foundations of HOSA Bowl, and Medical Spelling, which require a paired matchup or live spelldown, they forfeit their right to compete if a competitor does not provide a valid photo ID.
7. In cases of emergency or last-minute lost or stolen ID, and at the discretion of CE Management, a local advisor may identify a competitor in place of a photo ID. The intent of this rule is not to create hardships for competitors but to ensure the person registered for the event is competing in the event to help with event integrity. In rare cases, a local or state advisor may be allowed to identify the competitor in an emergency.

HOSA Competitor Identification Form

If an acceptable photo ID is unavailable, the competitor **must** complete the information below, have it signed by a school official, local HOSA advisor or notary, and present this form as the competitor's photo identification on the day of the event(s).

Student Competitor Instructions

Complete the document thoroughly in the designated student information areas.
Attach a recent photo of yourself local advisor, or notary. in the designated area.
Bring this form with you on the day of your competitive event.

School Official, Local Advisor, or Notary Instructions
