LA HOSA CODE OF CONDUCT

For All Members

To Be Returned to The Chapter Advisor

A good reputation enables members to take pride in their organization. Your conduct at any Louisiana HOSA function should make a positive contribution to the reputation that has been established. Your behavior at all times should be that it reflects credit to you, your family, your school, your state, and Louisiana HOSA.

- 1. Officer conduct is the responsibly of the local chapter advisor, state advisor, or chaperone. Students shall keep their authorized attending adult informed of their activities and whereabouts at all times.
- 2. You are expected to attend all meetings and other scheduled activities. Louisiana State name badges shall be worn at all times. You may not miss more than one regular monthly officer meeting.
- 3. Please be prompt and show respect to those in attendance. Officers are to report any accidents, injuries, or illnesses to their local chapter advisor, state advisor, or chaperone immediately.
- 4. Officers are expected to observe the designated curfew during any activities and at hotels. Curfew means being in your own room by the designated hour.
- 5. If a student is responsible for stealing or vandalism, the student and his/her parents will be expected to pay for any and all damages.
- 6. Any long-distance phone calls from hotels or other incidentals charged to room where officer stays during HOSA activities will be the responsibility of the individual student and/or parents. Members/participants attending the State Officer Retreat, or any HOSA activity may not purchase, consume or be under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs at any time. Violators will be subject to stringent disciplinary action.
- 7. Officers may not smoke cigarettes or use any vape or chew type product at or during any HOSA activity.
- 8. No weapons of <u>any sort</u> are allowed on a student's person, in their transportation vehicle or in their belongings at any HOSA activity.
- 9. Officers who disregard the rules will be subject to disciplinary action and will be sent home at their own expense. Parents will be notified.
- 10. Officers are to abide by the dress code policy at all meetings and activities as specified for that activity.

Meeting Protocol

All meetings should be enthusiastic, but we must not be rude or obnoxious to the others. Officers who do not adhere to meeting protocol will be asked to leave.
