HOSA APPENDIX G

ACCEPTABLE FORMS OF PHOTO IDENTIFICATION FOR COMPETITIVE EVENTS

- The competitor must present a valid current photo ID that is issued by a city, state or federal government agency or by the competitor's school. School ID's must be for the current academic year
- The first and last name must match as it appears on the event registration.
 - *In some cases, a competitor may go by a middle name or "Joe" vs "Joseph", etc. Event staff should use discretion in interpreting this part of the Appendix. The intent of requiring photo IDs is not to police a detail. The intent is to ensure the integrity of competition and that the person registered is in fact the person checking-in to compete.
- The photo must be current and recognizable.
- A photograph (digital or print) of the valid photo ID is also acceptable
- Examples:
 - Government-issued driver's license or non-driver ID card
 - Official school-produced student ID card from the school the competitor currently attends
 - Government-issued passport or U.S. Global Entry identification card
 - o Government-issued military or national identification card

If the competitor does not have an acceptable form of ID listed above, the HOSA Competitor Identification Form, found on the next page of this Appendix, may be completed and used.

1. Per GRR - At ILC, all competitors must have photo identification, as outlined in Appendix, for each round of competition. If a competitor comes to competition and does not have the proper photo ID with him or her, then the competitor will be allowed to compete but will receive 35 penalty points. Points will be deducted in Tabulations. For round 2 Biomedical Debate, HOSA Bowl, and Medical Spelling, which require a paired matchup and live spelldown, if a competitor does not provide a valid photo ID, they forfeit their right to compete.
