

LA HOSA CODE OF CONDUCT

To Be Returned to your Chapter Advisor

A good reputation enables members to take pride in their organization. Your conduct at any Louisiana HOSA function should make a positive contribution to the reputation that has been established. Your behavior at all times should be that it reflects credit to you, your school, your state and Louisiana HOSA.

1. Student conduct is the responsibility of the local chapter advisor. Students shall keep their advisors informed of their activities and whereabouts at all times.
2. You are expected to attend all general sessions and other scheduled conference activities. Louisiana State Leadership Conference name badges shall be worn at all times.
3. Please be prompt and show respect to those in the audience and on stage. Cell phones, iPads & iPods brought into general sessions must be on silent mode. No cell phones, or iPods, etc. may be brought into competitive events. No food or drinks are to be brought into competitive events.
4. Members are to report any accidents, injuries, or illnesses to their local or state advisor immediately.
5. Members are expected to observe the designated curfew. Curfew means being in your own room by the designated hour.
6. If a student is responsible for stealing or vandalism, the student and his/her parents will be expected to pay any and all damages.
7. Members/participants attending the State Leadership Conference may not purchase, consume or be under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs at any time. Violators will be subject to stringent disciplinary action.
8. No weapons of any sort are allowed on a student's person or in the transportation vehicle.
9. Students who disregard the rules will be subject to disciplinary action and will be sent home at their own expense. Parents will be notified.
10. Any long distance phone calls from the hotel will be the responsibility of the individual student and/or parents.
11. Members are to abide by the dress code policy at all business sessions, general sessions, competitive events and other conference activities.

General Sessions Protocol

The general sessions should be enthusiastic but we must not be rude or obnoxious to those in the audience or on stage. It is important to remain seated until the end of the session. Students who do not adhere to general session protocol will be asked to leave the Conference.
