PENNY WARS!

We will be hosting Penny Wars during the State Leadership Conference in February. All money collected will go to the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society.

Instructions:

1. Please see attached flyer and hang in your room, hallway, or anywhere you want! Show your members, and start collecting now. Advertise it at school! Decorate your jar for your chapter and bring it to Conference.
2. Make sure all members read the **Recognition Event Guidelines** for the recognition event of **National Service Project** on the HOSA website: <http://www.hosa.org/sites/default/files/NS14.pdf>
3. All money collected for Penny Wars will be donated to The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society (LLS). After the Penny Wars, we will send one check with a list of all the participating chapters and their amounts, to the area LLS.
4. Feel free to collect as much money as you can, besides pennies. **Safeguard the money you collect...**
5. **Before coming to conference**, you will want to count the money, and separate the bills and silver from the pennies. If you are required to deposit the money with your school, then bring a check to conference made out to: SWLAHEC/HOSA.
6. The amount you bring to conference is what will be reported to the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society on behalf of your chapter. We will verify this amount when you turn your money in upon arrival. Any additional amounts collected during conference will be split between the participating chapters and added submitted amount.
7. **Be sure to report this and the hours spent on the HOSA website.** This is where you keep track of the hours for the project. The direct link is in the Event Guidelines. (and above)
8. Penny Wars will take place during the Superhero Social Hour immediately following the Opening Session. During the social hour, chapters will place their jars in the designated secure area. Chapters will also have the opportunity to place money in other chapter's jars. (You might have to get sneaky!)
9. The Penny Wars chairperson and I will count the money at the end of the Social Hour, and the winning chapter (chapter with most points) will be announced during the Grand Awards Session.
10. **The winning HOSA chapter will receive a professionally made HOSA banner made specifically for your chapter.** If the winning school has already received a banner, they will receive an alternate & equivalent prize.
11. All participating chapters will receive a certificate of participation
12. You may start at any time....now is good!

This year, let's show everyone that Louisiana HOSA is working to fight blood cancer!

Louisiana HOSA Penny Wars Guidelines

These guidelines are to help LA Penny Wars be both successful and fun! It's a wonderful way to raise money towards the National Service Project of Leukemia & Lymphoma Society. Start collection now, and bring to the State Leadership Conference.

Rules:

1. The Goal of Penny Wars is to collect as many PENNIES as possible in your jar and put as many NON-PENNIES in everyone else's jar.
2. Money is worth "points" based on its monetary value.
3. Pennies give YOUR school **positive** points while nickels, dimes, quarters and bills take points away from the team's total.
 - Penny = 1 point
 - Nickel = 5 points
 - Dime = 10 points
 - Quarter = 25 points
 - 1 Dollar = 100 points
 - 5 Dollars = 500 points
 - 10 Dollars = 1,000 points
 - 20 Dollars = 2,000 points
4. Therefore, you want to put PENNIES in your school's jar (positive points) and nickels, dimes, quarters and bills (negative points) in the jars of other schools.
Example: you have 100 pennies in your jar (100 points)
But someone puts in a quarter (-25 points). Now you only have 75 points.
5. The school with THE MOST POINTS at the end of Penny Wars wins!!
(Prize will be awarded)
6. Money will be donated to LLS but credited to your school's chapter. Be sure to follow the rules located in the guidelines for the National Service Project.
